Year 1 - AUTUMN 2

Dear Parents / Carers,
Please find below the units that your child will be learning this term.

English

- **Non-fiction**-Write a Non- Chronological report about the local area Slough
- **Phonics** – Will be taught through the Read Write Inc scheme. The children will develop their knowledge and understanding of phonics. They will learn to apply the skills learnt in their reading and writing.
- **Grammar focus:** We will be developing children’s grammatical skills. We will be focusing on using adjectives and identifying nouns in a sentence.

Maths

- Identify and recognize the properties of 2D shapes
- Identify and recognize the properties of 3D shapes
- Place value-Finding different ways to make a number
- Add and subtract 1 digit and 2-digit numbers using different strategies
- Know numbers facts to 10 and 20
- Understand place value – The value of each digit in a number
- Number bonds of 10 and 20.
- Addition and subtraction using numbers to 20

We will deepen children’s understanding of concepts through a variety of reasoning and problem-solving tasks.

Science

Science: Seasonal Changes

- Observe changes across the seasons
- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies
- Study the different seasonal changes and compare them with different countries at certain times of the year
- Understand how weather forecasts can help inform our lives

MFL – Arabic

NUMBERS 0 – 10: Pupils in year 1 will learn how to count from 0 – 10 in Arabic, initially focusing on counting in sequence and advancing onto counting in mixed order. Regular revisits will be made to the topic of animals covered during the first half term where children will learn how to count animals. Focus will also be on writing the numbers with children describing how each number is written.

RE

Children will be learning about the importance of Ibaadah (worship). We will explore different places of worship and the building of the Ka’ba by Prophet Ibrahim AS. We will identify key features of the Ka’ba and their importance.

Music

This term children will learn the concept of pitch, defined as the perceived frequency of a sound. Students will investigate high sounds, characterised by a higher frequency, and low sounds, which have a lower frequency. The unit encourages creating high and low sounds, fostering an understanding of pitch variations

PE

Focus this Term – Games – Ball skills, building control and confidence (Sports coach)

In this unit pupils will explore and develop their fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling and dribbling with both hands and feet. They will look to perform these skills with increasing control and accuracy using co-ordination and balance.

Focus this Term – Exploring stories through Movement (Class Teacher)

In this unit pupils develop their understanding of the benefits of exercise and a healthy lifestyle on their physical body, their mood and their overall health

Computing

Programming A: Moving a robot

This term children will be learning about early programming concepts. Learners will explore using individual commands, both with other learners and as part of a computer program. They will identify what each floor robot command does and use that knowledge to start predicting the outcome of programs. The unit is paced to ensure time is spent on all aspects of programming and builds knowledge in a structured manner. Learners are also introduced to the early stages of program design through the introduction of algorithms.



Art

To explore the work of a local artist- John Percy_to use a range of materials creatively to design and make products. Final piece will be to create a collage based on John Percy's artwork.

NC Objectives:

To develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space

Drawing

- Use lines to represent objects seen

Collage

- Modify materials by tearing and cutting and find ways of joining them to assemble basic forms add surface features

Homework- Homework will be given out online on Microsoft Teams every **Friday and will need to** be completed by the following **Wednesday**. Please encourage children to independently complete homework as it will be set according to what is being learnt in class and will help reinforce and embed the learning.
