


Oceans of the World

There are five oceans in the world.





Pacific Ocean




Indian Ocean

The Indian Ocean is the third biggest ocean in the world. Even still, it is 5½ times the size of the USA! It is named after the country of India.


Southern Ocean





Indian Ocean



Atlantic Ocean



Here you will also find the largest breeding ground for humpback whales in the world.





Southern Ocean
