

Kenya's flag was adopted on December 12, 1963.

The black represents the **solidarity** of the people of Kenya.

The red represents blood from the **struggle** for freedom.

The green represents natural wealth, like **wildlife and national parks**.

The white represents peace.

The Masai shield and spears represents the **protection** of freedom.

The current design of the Union Jack dates from the [Act of Union 1707](#), which united the [Kingdom of Great Britain](#) and the [Kingdom of Ireland](#) (previously in [personal union](#)) to create the [United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland](#). The flag consists of the [red cross](#) of [Saint George](#) ([patron saint of England](#)), edged in white, superimposed on the [cross](#) of [St Patrick](#) ([patron saint of Ireland](#)), which are superimposed on the [Saltire of Saint Andrew](#) ([patron saint of Scotland](#)). [Wales](#) is not represented in the Union Flag by [Wales's patron saint, Saint David](#), as at the time the flag was designed [Wales was part of the Kingdom of England](#).
