RE: Year 5 remote learning

Dear Parents,

This letter is to inform you of the current situation regarding the online learning provision for Year 5 pupils. We know that you may find the need for your child to isolate for 14 days from today concerning, but we are continuing to monitor the situation and are working closely with Public Health England.

Your child should have all received their login details for the interactive platform MS TEAMS last term by their class teacher. If your child has misplaced or forgotten their passwords then please e-mail the class teacher or the school office (office@iqra.slough.sch.uk).

Online learning for Year 5 pupils will commence Wednesday 18th November following a parental support meeting on MS TEAMS on **Tuesday 17th November at 11am**. Teachers in this meeting will share the remote education provision with parents including:

- how to log into MS TEAMS learning platform
- the timetable for Year 5 pupils
- the continuity to teach all or most of the normal planned curriculum in the remote environment
- instructions on how to access learning support materials online.
- how to access the assignments
- how to read teacher feedback.

Accessing remote learning

As a school we have a limited number of devices available for pupils to support their remote learning at home. As a result, pupils who are receiving free school meals, those who are vulnerable and those pupils who have an Education Health Care plan will be prioritised. The government have advised that where mobile phones are accessible pupils should use these to access MS TEAMS.

We thank all parents for their continued support during these unprecedented times and pray that you and your families keep safe.
