

YEAR 2 –Autumn Term 1 Planning – Stone Age (History)

Cross Curricular: Writing: Explanations

NC Objectives:

- To write simple, coherent narratives fiction and nonfiction.
- To use a range of punctuations correctly throughout their writing.
- To use present and past tense correctly and consistently.
- Continue to use the diagonal and horizontal strokes needed to join letters
- I can write about real events recording these simply and clearly.
- I can write effectively for different purposes drawing on from my reading to inform the vocabulary and grammar in my writing.
- I can spell most common exception words.

Cross Curricular: VR goggles

Children will have the opportunity to travel back into the famous stone age caves and discover the symbolic messages.

Cross curricular: Science- Materials

Children will be exploring different materials and understanding why they are suitable.

NC objectives:

- I can say why a material is used for a particular job
- I can explain how some objects made from a material can be changed.
- I can name and group
- I can communicate my ideas, what I do and what I find out in a variety of ways.

Cross Curricular: PSHE

Children will be taught about the world around them and that not all families and people are the same.

NC Objectives: I can identify and respect the differences and similarities between people.

- I can identify special people to me (family, friends and carers), what makes them special and how special people should care for one another.
- I can understand that they belong to different groups and communities such as family and school.

History- NC Objectives:

Chronological understanding:

- To describe where people and events fit on a timeline.

Knowledge and Interpretation:

- To show awareness of the past.
- To understand changes within living memory.

Historical Enquiry:

- To show understanding of some of the ways we find out about the past and identify different ways in which it is represented.

Educational visit:

- Trip– travelling back to the stone age times.

Music

Children will be learning to sing together and perform the stone age stomp.

NC objectives

Perform songs, chants and rhymes with a good sense of pulse and rhythm

Cross Curricular: Reading:

Develop phonic knowledge, structure and vocabulary.

Build on comprehension skills.

NC Objectives:

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words until automatic decoding has embedded and readings fluent
- Read common exception words, noting unusual correspondences between spelling and sound and where these occur in the word.
- To discuss favourite parts, words and phrases from a range of extracts.
- To explain the mean of new words that I know and to find out meanings of words that are unknown.
- Explain what is happening in the text and to predict what will happen next.

Cross Curricular: Art/DT

To create cave paintings.
